ASILI ADVENTURE SAFARIS SAFETY PROTOCOL



- •Once you land in Kenya Uganda Tanzania Rwanda airports you will meet our Airport representative will be waiting to receive to receive you ensuring social distance is maintained, no handshakes and your luggage is well sanitized before being put in the vehicle.
- •Your Temperature will be checked and confirmed twice a day.
- •Your airport transfer vehicle will be cleaned and the surface areas sanitized.
- •You will be required to wear masks at alltimes and sanitize your hands while in the vehicle.
- •We shall use 7-seater vans for the airport transfers will carry a maximum of 4 travellers or a family of 6 as per the set travel guidelines.
- •The driver will be expected to wear a face mask and observe a social-distancing at all times







Our Safari Guides / Vehicles

The Safari Vehicles will come clean and well sanitized. Each vehicle will carry a maximum of 4 travellers, 6 travellers if travelling as one family.

The Guest Should carry hand sanitizers & Face Masks as a personal health precaution.

A 1.5 Metre rule is observed by leaving the Co-driver's seat vacant while on your safari.

Your luggage will be sanitized before entering the vehicle.

Hand sanitizer will be readily available in the vehicle.

Disposable PPEs will be available while in the vehicle.

Waste bins will be available in the Safari vehicle.

Your Tour-guide will follow strict social distancing protocols at all time.

Your tour guides will observe proper hygiene and mainain very high standards of professionalism while handling you.

The vehicles will be fitted with disposable head rests.

Clean drinking water will be provided to each traveller while aboard the vehicle.

Your safari tour-guide shall take your temperature reading twice daily and keep your daily temperature record as per the Government's directive.

After your safari, your luggage will be sanitized.

Our Safari vehicles will be fumigated and cleaned before/after every safari.



GAME DRIVES

As indicated earlier, our safari vehicles will carry a maximum of 4 travellers or 6 family members.

In cases of extra travellers, we will add an extra vehicle so as to observe the social distancing protocols.

The Health officials will screen the guest's temperatures upon entry of every Game Park.

Our Tour guides shall always have a face-mask on and wear proper hand gloves while handling the travellers.

We encourage each traveller to have his/her own essentials *i.e binoculars, goggles and water bottles* hence avoiding sharing.

Ample drinking water will be provided while on game drives.

While on game drives all travellers should always have a face mask on.

Each and every traveller is expected to adhere to strict social distancing protocols.

It is mandatory that all Guests have Medical insurances that will be ideal in case of any health complications you get.

The properties we work with, have been certified by the Countries Ministry of Health. Incase of any medical emergencies, it will be easier to access medical assistance.

You will be subjected to mandatory testing and in cases of questionable symptoms

Guests will be taken into quarantine for further check-ups and confirmations. If conditions go beyond local medical facilities abilities, we will offer evacuations covers to a certified hospital for more care

We have issuing Flying Doctors evacuation cover on all our safaris in case of any emergencies that require intensive care and attention.

In the event of evacuation, it will be facilitated by Amref International.

All guests are mandated to declare their medical condition with us while booking their tour.

What happens if a guest tests positive while on Safari?



In the event of a confirmed Covid 19 case while on safari, the guest will be given medical attention from a nearby licensed hospital before being evacuated immediately to Nairobi for proper Medical administration.

If the guest recovers and confirmed by medical experts fit for travel, they will be able to continue with their safari or fly back home.

All contact person who came into contact with the guest will be quarantined for 14 days as per the government directives and protocols.

Quarantine costs are all on the guest bill. We advise you budget for around USD \$.1,000 per person minimum, in case there are any positive cases while on your holiday.

AIR TRAVEL

All Flights within Kenya and East Africa at large have their own Set Protocols and guidelines to observe along with the required minimum standards to operate.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GUEST AHEAD OF TRAVEL

- 1. Valid COVID -19 certificate for past 14 days before travel
- 2. Valid COVID -19 certificate / Results before boarding a plane to any of our destinations
- 3. Valid Visa (Encouraged to apply online via www.ecitizen.go.ke) Obtain Visa in Advance
- 4. Valid Flight Return Tickets.
- 5. Provide yellow fever vaccination certificate too for Tanzania travel
- 6. Medical and Travel Insurance are mandatory
- 7. An extra 1000\$ insurance for quarantining accommodation in cases where a guest is confirmed COVID-19 positive. (It's refundable if paid together with a safari package)

No Stop-overs

While traveling from one park to the other our safari guides will ensure guest will only stop for toilet breaks in designated places that are not crowded. We shall take with us packed lunches to avoid stopping in restaurants on the way.

Cashless payments

We encourage our safari guests to make payments for their safaris online.
